National News

Document for Lalit Modi's Extraction submitted

- Enforcement Directorate (ED) officers submitted documents for the extradition of former cricket administrator Lalit Modi
- The documents were **required by Interpol** to extradite Lalit Modi
- Lalit Modi has been accused of money laundering by the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) Court

Supreme Court Questions validity of All India Bar Exam

- Supreme Court questioned if the conduct of the All India Bar Examination (AIBE) was a violation of the fundamental right to practice the profession.
- Law graduates must clear the AIBE with 2 years of enrolment to practice.
- The rules were notified in 2010 to improve the quality of the profession.
- The apex court has asked reports from the Law Commission on the issues of holding such an examination.

First Raisna Dialogue in New Delhi

- The Raisna Dialogue conference has started in Delhi.
- It is intended to rival conferences such as **Munich Conference**, **Shangri-La Dialogue in Singapore** that attract global players.
- It is attended by speakers from 40 countries.
- Tension between India and Pakistan have slowed South Asian integration.
- There is a call for greater south Asian cooperation and economic integration

Chennai gets smart self-cleaning toilets in India

- They are free to use.
- Each toilet cleans itself with 5 liters of water after 3 minutes of usage and 4.5 liters if usage is longer.
- 43 toilets are specially for women
- Each toilet costs Rs 4.5 lakh.
- **1600** such toilets have been provided in **16 Indian states** to various private organizations.

Food Security Scheme implemented in 47 districts in UP

- All of UP districts are now covered under the food scheme.
- Beneficiaries get subsidized food grains. Wheat at Rs 2, rice at Rs 3 per kg. Each beneficiary will get 5kg per month.
- The scheme will benefit 1.64 crore people in 40 lakh households.
- 75% of population of the state will benefit from the scheme.
- **50 districts** were declared as **drought hit** in 2015.

Military Exercise FORCE 18 started in Pune

- It involves participants from 18 countries.
- 10 members of the Association of South East Asian Nations (ASEAN)
 - o Brunei
 - o Cambodia
 - o Laos
 - o Indonesia
 - o Malaysia
 - o Myanmar
 - o Philippines
 - o Singapore
 - o Thailand
 - o Vietnam

It will conclude on March 8 2016.

Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Rural Electrification Scheme

- Every house to be **electrified by 2018**.
- Aims to augment power supply to rural areas and strengthen sub transmission and distribution lines
- Separate agricultural and non-agricultural feeders.
- Increase number of hours of power supply in rural areas
- Reduction in peak load
- Improvement in billed energy by metered consumption.
- Center has provided a grant of **63000 crore**

- Micromax has become the third largest Russian market recently.

- India has been ranked 90th place in list of 126 countries
- Report is compiled in accordance with **Global Energy Architecture Performance Index compiled by WEF**
- Report is prepared in collaboration with Accenture
- Ranking is done on basis of ability to provide energy access across the 'energy triangle'
 - Affordability
 - o Environment sustainability

Iraq to fight Sunni militancy

- The battle to **retake Mosul** has gained an upper hands in recent months.
- US backed forces have begun laying the groundwork to isolate Mosul from IS HQ in Raqqa, Syria.
- Kurdish and Arab forces retook the town of Shaddadi in Eastern Syria.
- It took 5 months to gain control of the city center of Ramadi, the capital of Anbar province.

Myanmar to vote for President on March 10

- The announcement leaves little time for **Aung San Suu Kyi** to get the top spot.
- The current democracy figurehead is currently **banned** from becoming President according to **junta-era constitution**.
- Negotiations have failed to reach a deal to clear her path to power.
- Her National League for Democracy (NLD) party won victory at the elections.

Indo-WB Financing Agreement inked

- World Bank, Govt of India and Govt of Madhya Pradesh have signed a credit agreement worth \$300 million.
- It is for Madhya Pradesh Higher Education Quality Improvement Project
- Credit has been given by International Development Association (IDA)
- Sanctioned for 25 year period with a 5 year grace period.

RBI unlocks 40000 crores to capitalize banks

- Relaxation of norms in balance sheet to unlock 40000 crores.
- Will support capital requirements of Indian banks
- Indian banks are facing huge losses due to Non-performing assets what have eroded capital.

• The revised RBI norms give **public sector banks (PSB)** access to additional capital of **Rs 35000 crore**.

India's GDP growth to hike by 7.8% in 2016-17

- Nomura predicts India's GDP growth will go from 7.6% to 7.8% in 2016-17
- GDP growth will be based on discretionary demand driven by **7**th **pay commission.**
- Also decided by various other factors
 - Wage hike
 - Low inflation
 - High corporate probability
 - o Ongoing implementation of public capital expenditure

Infosys to collaborate with Microsoft on Analytics solution

- Infosys will offer healthcare analytic solutions on Microsoft Intelligent Cloud Technology
- It is now possible to **store and analyze large volumes of structured and unstructured datasets at low cost**
- Will provide managed care organizations with tools to improve clinical and operational effectiveness at reasonable costs.
- Will provide health-care call centers with customer support and self-service options to both health care workers and consumers.

Delhi Government to launch HPV vaccine

- Recent research shows that 122844 women are diagnosed with cervical cancer.
- 67477 die from the disease every year in India.
- Vaccination will be given for **6th standard in 2 phases**. It will be later given to girls between **9-13 years of age**.
- 80% of cervical cancers can be prevented.
