India's rank slips for proportion of Women in Parliament

- Slipped from a rank of **117 among 188 countries** in 2014 to **144 among 191** countries
- 16th Lok Sabha has the highest number of women ever
- 12% of MPs in the Lok Sabha are women. 12.8% in Rajya Sabha

- Global average is 22%.
- Rwanda ranks #1 with 63.8% women in the lower house of parliament and 38.5% in the upper house.

India at bottom of ranking for women membership at top science academics

- Drop in the number of women researchers at Indian National Science
 Academy (INSA) in the past three years.
- 15% of all members in 2010
- 6% in 2013
- Of 864 members in 2013, only 52 were women
- Until 2014, INSA had no woman in its 31-member governing body.

Tobacco use down in country

- **Dip** in the use of all forms of **tobacco**, among men and women
- Hailing as one of the biggest successes in public health.
- In **Sikkim**, there is up to **20% dip in tobacco use.**
- Manipur and Meghalaya show increase in consumption
- Tobacco industry too has been reporting a consistent dip in production since 2011.

International South Korea and US Begin Military Exercise

Training involves about 17,000 American troops and more than 300,000
 South Korean troops.

Business and Economy Forecast of India's growth at 7.5 maintained

- The forecast is by Global Rating Agency Fitch
- Sees higher growth over the next two financial years.
- 8% growth in short term is not possible
- Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth forecast for India is at 5%

- Responsibility for delivery of tax payer services has been assigned at every level in the field offices.

- Proposed Centre is for Research and Development unit and a product testing center.
- Centre will come up at **Tamil Nadu Government owned Electronics Corporation** in Chennai.
- Will be Co-developer of the Automotive Company for Developing IT/ITES services related to Automotive, Finance and Allied sectors.
- Company will be eligible for **all tax concessions** available for investment in the zones.

Reliance-Jio to Offer Free Wi-Fi Services in 6 Stadiums

- The move is launched ahead of the T-20 World Cup
- The stadiums are:

A 'meta-skin' to cloak objects from radars

- Flexible, stretchable and tunable
- Can protect objects from radar detection
- Can help to develop next generation of stealth aircraft or even invisibility cloaks
- By stretching and flexing the polymer meta-skin, it can be **tuned to reduce** the reflection of a wide range of radar frequencies.
- Technology will find applications in electromagnetic frequency tuning, shielding and scattering suppression.
