- The policy will come into effect from 1 April 2016
- Social welfare department has been made the **nodal agency** for this new policy.
- Policy reserves 25 percent seats in these old age homes for the BPL families
- Will be provided free residence and food
- Declared to raise monthly pension from Rs.300 to Rs.400.

India's First Education Focused Accelerator Program Started at MIT, PUNE

- Eduglid has been set up by Maharashtra Institute of Technology at Pune.
- Edugild will conduct two batches every year.
- Start-ups will receive seed funding worth Rs. 15 lakh in return for a minority stake.

Jammu & Kashmir adopts new Industrial policy

- New industrial policy to attract an investment of Rs.2000 crores every year.
- The policy will hold good for 10 years.

Maharashtra passes Prohibition of Social Boycott bill

- Move to strengthen the laws against discrimination
- Social boycott is prohibited and its commission shall be an offence.
- Maximum punishment for social boycotting will be 7 years in prison or fine up to 5 lakh rupees or both

- Has been organized by the Children's Film Society of India.
- Children films from the country and abroad are to be screened
- Workshops on film making, storytelling and creative writing will be held

Anti-Corruption Bureau setup in Karnataka

- To provide a transparent and efficient administration.
- ACB will be a statutory authority to investigate graft offences
- Under the direct supervision of the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (DPAR)
- ACB will have no power to initiate a probe on decisions taken or recommendations made by public servants, without prior permission from the appointing authority.
- An Inspector General of Police (IGP) rank officer will head the vigilance cell within ACB
- ACB will be headed by an Additional Director General of Police-rank officer.
- It will have an IGP rank officer, 10 superintendents of police and a 322member force.

Supreme Court asks Centre to frame rules for child adoption

- Asked the center to put in place a "credible mechanism" for intra and inter-country adoption of children.
- New mechanism should lay down rules and regulations similar to the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015.



China to set up an International Maritime Judicial Centre

- To handle territorial disputes.
- China has been consistently fighting with its neighbors in Maritime borders in South China Sea.

- Htin Kyaw is the first civilian president in over fifty years of military rule
- He is a **close ally of Aung Sang Suu Kyi** who cannot hold the constitutional post herself.

Govt Bans More Than 300 Combination Drugs

- Includes **two widely used cough syrups**, and **Vicks Action 500** being sold without government approval.
- Banned medicines include the codeine-based cough syrups Phensedyl and Corex. Phensedyl is made by U.S. drug maker Abbott Laboratories
- Its sales are estimated to make up more than 3 percent of Abbott's \$1
 billion India revenue.

Europe and Russia launched Exo-Mars to explore the Red Planet

- Europe and Russia launched an unmanned spacecraft, named ExoMars
 2016 to explore if life once existed on the Red Planet and possibilities for the same.
- Joint endeavor between European Space Agency (ESA) and the Russian space agency, Roscosmos.

Earthquake Warning System Installed at Haryana Govt's Building

- The only building in India to have an Earthquake Warning System installed onsite.
- Around **26 countries** in the world **have this technology already.**
- This system can save lives by giving alert of a future earthquake well ahead of time.

Wikipedia Developing Speech Engine for Visually Impaired Users

 Wikimedia Sweden has partnered with the KTH Royal Institute of Technology in Sweden to develop the crowd-sourced speech engine

- Project aims to provide access to Wikipedia and other wikis to people with reading difficulties or visual impairment.
- The service will initially be available in Swedish language.
- Researchers will begin developing the engine for Swedish, English, and Arabic, which they aim to complete by September 2017.

February breaks global temperature records

- February broke 100 year old temperature records by a 'shocking' amount.
- This is according to data released by NASA.
- data shows the average global surface temperature in February was 1.35C
 warmer than the average temperature for the month between 1951-1980
- This has led scientists to declare a 'climate emergency'.
