Japan says India's nuclear MoU "legally binding"

- India had committed to adhere to the "control of nuclear material, traceability [of nuclear fuel] and consequence in case of a nuclear accident"
- Memorandum of understanding (MoU) on civil nuclear cooperation with Japan signed in April 2015
- India will be financially accountable if it is found to be violating the principles.
- MoU may also destabilize India's established nuclear deals with Russia and France. Previous demand for such commitments were denied.
- The bilateral agreement leaves out India's military nuclear program

Prime minister launched Kisan Suvidha mobile app

- Will provide information on subjects such as weather, seeds,market prices, pesticides, fertilizers, and agriculture machinery.
- Developed to help farmers by providing relevant information to them quickly.

Indian Air Force successfully conducted exercise Iron Fist in Pokhran

- The day and night exercise was aimed at **demonstrating IAF's combat and fire power**
- It showcased its **commitment and capabilities in safeguarding national interests.**

Freedom of expression does not mean call to destroy country

- Two-day national executive kept its political preoccupations, both with the debate on nationalism and its attempts at making up with the Dalit community
- Gave political resolution that "freedom of expression and nationalism do necessarily co-exist" but that this fundamental right does not cover calls to destroy the country

• The party and the government "was accepting of political criticism of itself, but not of the nation

International

Agreement between the EU and Turkey to tackle the migrant crisis

- Migrants arriving in Greece will be **sent back to Turkey** if their **asylum claim is rejected.**
- EU will resettle Syrian migrant for each Syrian returned to Turkey.
- Priority will be given to those who have not tried to illegally enter the EU.
- By June 2016, it will be mandatory for **Turkish nationals to have access to the Schengen passport-free zone.**
- EU is to speed up the allocation of €3 billion (\$3.3 billion) in aid to Turkey to help migrants' crisis.

U.S. President to make historical Cuba visit

- The visit attempts to reverse generations of U.S. attempts to cut Cuba from the outside world
- Obama was due to see old town Havana, hold talks with Cuban President Raul Castro on Monday, and attend a baseball game.
- For Cubans dreaming of escaping isolation and reinvigorating their threadbare economy, the visit has created huge excitement.
- Republicans and some human rights activists have also criticized Obama for dealing with Castro.
- Freedom in Cuba, ranging from the media to politics and economic entrepreneurship, remain highly curtailed.

Business and Economy Interest rate cut to help economy

- Economy needs lower interest rates to become more efficient and high deposit rates would keep it "sluggish."
- To make the economy more efficient rather than sluggish, the country has
 to move towards lower interest rates in lending and deposits.

- Interest rates will be reset every quarter based on a formula linked to the rate of return on government securities.
- Returns on Public Provident Fund savings **cut from 8.7% to 8.1%** and **one year post office deposits from 8.4% to 7.1%.**

Banks are likely to reduce interest rates on home and car loans

- Banks likely to announce revised interest rates, starting April 1, which will lower the amount on deposits and make home and car loans cheaper.
- Reserve Bank of India has been urging banks to cut lending rates in line with the reduction in policy interest rate.
- Cut in small savings rate now gives more room to banks to reduce their deposit rates.
- Banks will shift to Marginal Cost of Funds based Lending Rate (MCLR) from 1 April, as directed by RBI.
- This new regime of loan pricing will replace the existing regime of Base
 Rate

Science and Technology

Fund to tackle anti-microbial resistance

- Launched by Dept. of Biotechnology to tackle the threat faced by India from resistance to antimicrobial drugs
- This is an India-focused seed fund.
- DBT has invested an initial \$1,00,000 in this fund.
- Also expected to **encourage biotechnology start-ups** in the country.

Solar for Refrigerator and air conditioner

- Chennai-based company has showed that solar power can be used to power air conditioner and refrigerator.
- Possible by the use of thin film solar panels.
- Company has replaced the **conventional silicon crystalline panels** with **thin film solar panels**.
- Energy yield of thin film is higher than silicon panel.
- For every 1 degree Celsius increase in temperature, the loss in power rating is 0.5% in the case of silicon panels; it is only 0.25% with thin films.

Space probe New Horizons result revealed by NASA

- After a 9.5-year, three-billion-mile journey New Horizons zipped by Pluto on July 14 last year.
- NASA scientists have revealed the former "astronomer's planet" and its "intriguing system of small moons" in a comprehensive set of papers describing results from last summer's Pluto system flyby.
- New Horizons' seven science instruments collected about 50 gigabits of data on the spacecraft's digital recorders

- Women's Singles Title was won by He Bingjiao from China after defeating Wang Yihan

 Skaarup Rasmussen after defeating Chinese Taipei pair of Lee Sheng-mu and Tsai Chia-hsin
- Women's Doubles was won by Japanese pair of Shizuka Matsuo and Mami Naito after defeating Japanese pair of Naoko Fukuman and Kurumi Yonao.
