National News India to host BRICS summit in October

- The summit will be **hosted in Goa**.
- India assumed chairmanship of BRICS from Russia on February 15, 2016 and it will last till December 31 2016.
- Core-theme will be **building responsive**, inclusive and collective solutions for the grouping.
- India's emphasis would be on institution building, implementation of previous commitments flowing from the past summits, and exploring synergies among the existing mechanisms.

Health Ministry launches Longitudinal Ageing Study in India

- This is the largest survey of its kind.
- It will survey more than 60,000 elderly over 25 years plan.
- Jointly funded by the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, the United States' National Institute on Ageing, and the United Nations Population Fund-India.
- Will investigate various health structures, and impact of social determinants on health of the elderly. It will also help in framing evidence-based policy.
- Will help design policies to mainstream the elderly, to reduce their vulnerabilities and enhance access to various services.

Punjab Assembly passes Agriculture Indebtedness bill

- Provides relief to the farmers. The bill specifies that the interest payable on debt shall be calculated at such rate as may be notified by the government.
- This would be in accordance with the interest rates charged by banks on yearly basis.

Wages of NREGS hiked by 6%

• A new committee has been appointed to revise the wage calculation formula for the MGNREGA workers.

The wages will be calculated on **CPI-rural index**

• The current scheme of wages is based on the agricultural labor index

India Post releases customized 'My Stamp' on HAL

• The stamp is released in recognition of the company's **75 years services to the nation.**

Telangana signs pact with French aviation trainer

- A training institute will come up at **Begumpet Airport** in **Hyderabad**.
- The French company plans to set up an academy to **train local talent** in addition to skilled workforce for the **maintenance**, **repair and overhaul**.
- Program aiming to train at least **1,000 students a year in aerospace and** related areas.

Government clears new Defense Procurement Policy

- Key changes to accord **priority to locally made equipment** and **fund private-sector R&D**
- Policy will come into effect from **April 1, 2016**.
- Will introduce measures to promote indigenization and self-reliance in defense
- Will be unveiled at the Defexpo India 2016
- Government will come with the update in Ordnance Factory Board and Defense Procurement Manuals in two months.

NTPC starts 250 MW unit in Bihar

• Total capacity of Nabinagar Thermal Power Station has become 250 MW and the total installed capacity of NTPC group has become 45,798 MW

Consumer Affairs Ministry signs MoUs to promote consumer welfare

- Has signed MoUs with the Industry bodies
- MoUs broadly covers the collaborative programs on developing and implementing a self-regulatory code of fair business practices

• MoU initiates advocacy action against unfair trade practices and preventing fake, counterfeit and sub-standard products and services and adoption of voluntary standards.

Central Government amends Atal Pension Yojana(APY)

- The **spouse of the subscriber** shall be entitled to **receive the same pension** amount as that of the subscriber **until the death of the spouse**
- After death of both the subscriber and the spouse, the nominee of the subscriber shall be entitled to receive the pension wealth, as accumulated till age of 60 years of the subscriber.

- Will be deployed in Seychelles till March 23, 2016
- Will help in curbing illegal activities and piracy and ensuring stability and safety in the Indian Ocean region

Environment & Ecology

New standards for gensets

- **First time** such **mandated certifications** have been notified for gensets running on LPG or natural gas or in combination with diesel and petrol.
- Primary aim is **to control air and noise pollution** emanating from the gensets.
- Standards will be **revisited in 4-5 years** once air and noise emission quality data and technological details pertaining to the gensets are available.

India's Agasthyamala Biosphere Reserve added to list of perfect biospheres

- There are 669 biosphere reserves in as many as 120 countries.
- Out of **18 biosphere reserves in India**, Agasthyamala Biosphere Reserve is the **tenth one to be included** in the **UNESCO World Biosphere Reserve Network.**

- It covers about **3500 square kilometres**, and is part of **Tirunalveli and Kankyakumari in Tamil Nadu, and Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam and Patanamthitta in Kerala.**
- More than 2,250 species of dicotyledonous plants are in the area and 29 are endemic to the region.
- It is home to more than **2000 species of plants**, three wildlife sanctuaries and a tiger reserve

Sundarbans becomes no-pollution zone

- Objective of this program to maintain a clean and green Sundarbans this polling season.
- A consensus was reached to **restrict the use of plastic or any other non-biodegradable material** during the campaign.
