India's first semi-high speed train flagged off

- Train runs at a speed of **160 km per hour**, covering the **184 kilometer distance between Delhi and Agra in 105-110 minutes.**
- Train coaches have been made at **Kapurthala Railway Coach Factory** in the Punjab
- **Bio-toilets** developed by the **Defence Research and Development** Organisation (DRDO).

"Stand Up India" scheme Launched

- To promote entrepreneurship.
- A Web portal for the scheme launched in **Noida, Uttar Pradesh.**
- Initiative is taken to elevate entrepreneurship among Scheduled Caste/Schedule Tribe and Women by providing loans between Rs. 10 Lakhs to Rs. 100 Lakhs.
- **5100 E-Rickshaws** also distributed at the launch event by **Bhartiya Micro Credit (BMC)** under the Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojna scheme.

UIDAI produced 100 crore Aadhaars

- First Aadhaar was issued in 2010.
- Achieved just after the government notification of Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and other Subsidies, benefits and services) Act, 2016
- Will give statutory support to exchange of subsidies and advantages to qualified individuals having Aadhaar (UID) number.

- Panama Papers say **500 Indians being named** for illegal fund holdings in abroad.
- World's most prominent people and hundreds of Indians have been named.

- Policy seeks to attract \$3 billion investment to the State and create about
 6 lakh jobs.

Denial of AMU minority status verdict upheld

- Government has made it clear in the Supreme Court that the government is convinced that the 1967 Constitution Bench judgment, which had held that AMU was not "established" by Muslims, still held sway.
- Azeez Basha versus Union of India verdict of the Supreme Court had denied AMU protection under Article 30 of the Constitution.
- In 1981, Parliament restored the minority status to the university. But the Allahabad High Court in January 2006 struck down the provision of the AMU

India at 6th position in top-10 manufacturers list

- United Nations Industrial Development Organization has placed India at 6th among the world's top 10 largest manufacturing countries.
- China tops the list of 10-top industrial producers
- Other countries include US, Japan, Germany and Korea. Indonesia is at number 10 position.



"Global Report on Urban Health" publicized

- Compared data on health from urban areas of 100 countries.
- Report was led and written by the WHO Centre for Health Development in Kobe, Japan.

- Has been launched by Philippines.

World's First White Tiger Safari Opened in Madhya Pradesh

- Sanctuary is spread over an area of **25 acre** and is built at a **cost of Rs 50 crore.**
- There are three white tigers and two Royal Bengal tigers.
- Nine more white tigers will arrive in the coming months.
- World's first white tiger was discovered in the Vindhya region around 100 years ago.

- Safari will be named after **Rewa princely state's ruler Maharaja Martand Singh** who had a 'pet' white tiger named Mohan in 1951.
- It **became the progenitor of all known white tigers** in the world after the ruler arranged for its breeding.
