Recommendations of the 14th Finance Commission on Fiscal Deficit approved

- Permitted to the states with adequate finance to borrow an extra 0.5% of their GDP, beyond the 3% stipulated by the 14th Finance Commission, in order to help them to meet their development needs.
- Approved it with year to year flexibility for additional deficit of about 0.5%.
