3rd Asia Ministerial Conference on Tiger Conservation

- More than **700 tiger experts, scientists, managers, donors and other stakeholders** are gathering to discuss issues related to tiger conservation.
- Ministers and government officials from all Tiger Range Countries are participating in the conference.

India, US 'agree in principle' on sharing military logistics

- **Growing interaction between armed forces of the two countries** is a "significant aspect of bilateral relationship".
- India has more joint exercises with the US than any other country in the world.
- Details of the logistic support is yet to be decided.

Shan-E-Punjab Express fitted with CCTV cameras

- First train in the country to get CCTV cameras
- CCTV system includes 4 to 6 Cameras per coach with Digital Video Recorder (DVR)
- System shall facilitate **facial recognition for unambiguous identification of the target** person by giving resolution images, **enable facial recognition in low light condition**
- Installation of surveillance systems was done through Ms/ A-Paul Instrument Company at an approximate cost of 36.71 lakh.

Mufti Sayeed Food Entitlement Scheme announced in J&K

- People who are covered under the State's public distribution system will get additional
 5kg of ration per person
- This is in addition to 5kg of ration they are entitled to get under NFSA.
- new scheme would be uniform scale of rations for all areas and food preferences of consumers would be taken care of
- Instead of wheat 75% population would get Atta.

UNICEF signs MoU with GITAM University

- MoU to empower the adolescents 10-19 years and address the adolescent issues in the
 district.
- Other districts that deal with adolescents issue are:
 - o Purulia in West Bengal
 - o Sibsahar in Assam
 - o EastSinghbum in Jharkhand

Three Member Committee for Content Regulation of Government Advertising

- Committee would be chaired by Shri B.B. Tandon, Former Chief Election Commissioner of India.
- Committee would address complaints from the general public of violation on the implementation of the guidelines set out by Supreme Court
- Committee would also take **suo motu cognizance of any violation / deviation of the guidelines**
- Committee may recommend suitable changes to the Supreme Court guidelines to deal with new circumstances and situations that may arise
- Committee is **not bound by any legal rules of evidence** and may follow such procedure that appears to it to be fair and proper for **swift settlement of grievances**

Maharashtra Legislative Council clears Bill to regulate dance bars

- Dance bars have not been banned but stringent conditions have been imposed to
 ensure that no owner comes forward to set up a dance bar.
- All performances will have to be approved by the censor board for theatre performances.
- Following its clearance in the Upper House, the Bill will now be introduced in the Assembly.

SC defends Lodha panel

- Lodha committee was set up by the Supreme Court to recommend reforms in the Board of Control for Cricket in India
- Committee suggested the **restructuring of the BCCI's administrative set-up**, proposing the **position of a CEO accountable to a nine-member apex council.**
- **CEO to be assisted by 6 professional managers** and the team of CEO and managers will be accountable to the apex council.
- It also suggested that a person cannot be a BCCI office-bearer and a state association office-bearer at the same time.

80% of India's population is not covered under any health insurance scheme

- Around **86% of the rural population and 82% of the urban population** are not covered under any scheme of health expenditure support.
- In urban areas, over **90% of the poorest residents are not covered**, while the figure is **66% for the richest residents.**
- Poorer households appear unaware or are beyond the reach of such coverage, both in rural and urban areas.

Bharti Airtel's payments Bank Unit approved

- First entity to receive final approval from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to start a payments bank.
- Will set up the payments bank in partnership with Kotak Mahindra Bank, which holds
 9% stake in Airtel M Commerce
- Reserve Bank's in-principle approval was valid for 18 months

Housing finance cos exempted from XBRL filings

- Corporate Affair Ministry has exempted housing finance companies from filing financial statements in XBRL format.
- Banking, insurance, power sector and non-banking finance companies are already exempted.

UIDAI asks online retails to stop collecting AADHAR information of customers

- Ministry of communications and IT has also warned the general public against sharing personal information on e-commerce platforms.
- Ministry has also warned that collecting information related to Aadhaar card or its unauthorized printing or aiding such persons in any manner may amount to a criminal offence punishable with imprisonment.

Science and Technology

Proof to link Zika virus with brain defects

- Several cases of microcephaly, a rare birth defect in which the brain fails to grow properly, continue to be reported in Brazil following the outbreak of Zika virus.
- How quickly the neural stem cells get infected with Zika virus became clear when the researchers detected it just 24 hours after they were exposed.

- While those cells not infected with the virus generated normal neurospheres, the virus-infected neural cells generated neurospheres with abnormalities.
- At the end of six days, the virus killed most of the neurospheres.

World's longest-ever captured python dies in Malaysia

- Giant python weighing 250 kg found on a Malaysian building site died after giving birth
- The current record for longest snake ever caught is 7.67m.
- The spotted python was 8m in length
