#### Cabinet approves signing the Paris Agreement

• Adopted at the **21st Conference of Parties held in Paris in last December**.

#### Gold Finial unveiled at Humayun's Tomb

- 18 feet tall Finial at Humayun's Tomb, New Delhi as part of the ongoing conservation effort.
- Tomb is a UNESCO World Heritage Site one of three in the capital has reinstated with a gold crown.
- Humayun's Tomb is model of the 18-feet tall structure weighs about 300-kg finial made of 4
  percent pure copper and plated with 3.5 kg of 24-carat gold.

- Support exchange of ideas and values amongst youth of different countries and help in developing international view among the youth.
- Will pave the way for people-to-people contacts, these Programs promote peace and understanding and strengthen friendly relations between countries.

#### MoU between India and Bhutan on Technical Cooperation

• Technical cooperation in the field of capacity building, benchmarking and bilateral exchange in infrastructure engineering.

#### Ceasefire in Nagaland extended by one year

- Agreement targets to bring lasting peace in the state of Nagaland with the involvement of Naga people.
- Both the sides agreed that the ceasefire will follow Ceasefire Ground Rules (CFGR) as mutually ratified
- CFGR will subject to mutual review and amendment with the involvement of both the parties.

#### India to Purchase 145 M777 Howitzers

- 145 M777 Howitzers for \$750 million to prepare the Mountain Strike Corps.
- Decision to buy ultra-light Howitzers produced by UK based BAE Systems under the Make In India
- Under Make in India initiative BAE Systems had tied up Mahindra as its business partner for its proposed in-country assembly, integration and test (AIT) facility for the M777 Howitzer.

#### Deen Dayal Jan Awas Yojana notified

- Haryana government has notified the Affordable Plotted Housing Policy 2016 for low and medium standard towns
- To achieve the goal of providing houses for all which will facilitate creation of additional affordable housing in these towns.

#### Unauthorized places of worship insult to God.

- Supreme Court has expressed anguish over inaction of authorities for allowing the existence of unauthorized places of worship on roads and pavements across the country
- Court has warned chief secretaries of states and Union territories of serious consequences if they did not comply with its orders directing removal of such religious structures

#### Most of rural India still opts for open defecation: NSS report

- nation-wide rapid survey was conducted during May-June 2015, concurrently with the 72nd round of the NSS
- 52.1% of people in rural India choose open defecation compared to 7.5% in urban India.
- Survey was to track the government's flagship program, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan.

#### Trading bloc to India: cut tariffs

- Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership has asked India to agree to eliminate tariffs on most products quickly
- Or else, India has to leave the talks on the proposed Free Trade Agreement (FTA).

#### New PF withdrawal norms on hold

- A complete and unconditional rollback of new PF norms that barred employees from withdrawing their provident fund corpus before retirement.
- Previously, employees had been allowed to withdraw the total EPF amount before retirement for medical emergencies, to fund children's marriage or while changing jobs.
- Under the norms that now stand reversed, employees could withdraw their own share of PF savings along with the interest on them.

# International India ranked at 133 on World Press Freedom Index

- Shows the levels of freedom that journalists, News Organizations enjoy in the country
- India gains at **133 among 180 countries** in the recent annual meeting of World Press freedom Index
- Finland is in first place for the sixth consecutive year. Netherlands and Norway follow.

## Business and Economy Health insurance cards distributed in Punjab

- Issued 303074 pre-active cashless Farmers Health Insurance Cards under Bhagat Puran Singh Sehat Bima Yojna in the maiden phase of project.
- Scheme enables farmers and their families to get health cover up to Rs 50,000 for their treatment and compensation of Rs 5 Lakhs in case of death

#### IFMR Capital initiates first capital market transaction for MUDRA

- Joint initiative would facilitate accelerated impact on the sector by leveraging MUDRA's capital and risk appetite.

- Short term transaction with tenure of 1.5 years. Which in turn will gain exposure to over 100 high quality MFIs and NBFCs in the Nation.
