- Land, acquired in the name of residential or commercial projects, should revert to its rightful owner the farmer in case the project does not take off.

- constitution of a panel under Former Revenue Secretary and Rajya Sabha MP N.K. Singh to review the Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management (FRBM) Act of 2003.
- Committee will review the working of the Act in the context of the uncertainty and volatility of global economy and suggest changes
- Committee will examine whether a **broad fiscal deficit range should be adopted in place of specific target.**
- Committee will also **provide an assessment of the impact of its recommendations** on the government deficit and FRBM parameters.

Italian Parliament approves same-sex civil unions

- Italian senate has passed legislation **legalizing same-sex civil unions**, with 372 voting in favour, 51 against and 99 abstaining.
- more than 20 countries have legalised gay marriage.
- law also makes this right available to unmarried heterosexual couples.
- With this, it has become the last country in Western Europe to do so
