#### Tatkal window for faster patents to startups

- plans to significantly cut down the time period for granting of patents to one-and-a-half years from the existing five to seven years.

# States asked to convert 3,784 urban areas into statutory Urban Local Bodies

- necessary for planned and coordinated infrastructure development, enhancement of revenues and efficient delivery of services to citizens leading to overall growth of economic activities.
- Census Town is an area with urban characteristics like a minimum population of 5,000, at least 75% of the male main working force engaged in non-agricultural activities and population density of at least 400 persons per sq.km
- Statutory Town is one with a municipality, corporation, cantonment board or notified town area committee.

#### Bonded labour rehab to be made Central sector scheme

- scheme proposes to increase the Budget provision from 5 crore to about 47 crore per annum.
- male bonded labourer would get a financial assistance Rs 1 lakh, while a child or woman would of get Rs 2 lakh. This would go up to Rs 3 lakh in case of a differently-abled or physically challenged bonded labourer.



- India is planned to add 300 million new urban residents by 2050 and it is required to build Climate Friendly cities to deal the challenge of accommodating the needs of the Population growth
- Urged the Government of India to build 100 new cities with low infrastructure, denser and low energy to avoid the addition of Greenhouse gases
- Contribution of urban areas more than 60 per cent of the GDP and an extra 300 million new urban residents are projected by 2050

#### UNICEF and EU Launch #Emergency Lessons Campaign

- #Emergency Lessons campaign on education in countries like Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Slovenia, Slovakia and the United Kingdom.
- **Social media-driven public awareness campaign** aimed at **reaching 20 million** Europeans and emphasising the vital role of education for children.

### Oil-for-drugs deal likely with crisis-hit Venezuela

- India has proposed an **oil-for-drugs barter plan** with cash-strapped Venezuela to recoup millions of dollars.
- payment mechanism would allow Venezuela to repay some of the amount owed with oil.

- Will shut its banking operations in India having given up on efforts to find a buyer
- to reduce its international operations to 13 countries from the current 38.
- It has less than **400 employees** in India and 10 retail branches.

#### India successfully test fires its indigenously developed Prithvi-II missile

- as part of a user trial by the army from a launch complex-3 of the Integrated Test Range (ITR) at Chandipur in **Odisha**.
- Missile have a strike range of 350 km also capable of carrying 500 kg to 1,000 kg of warheads and is thrusted by liquid propulsion twin engines
- DRDO developed Prithvi is India's first indigenously-built ballistic missile.
- One of the five missiles under the country's Integrated Guided Missile Development Program.

### Hypersonic test flight promises to shrink world

Hypersonic technology was recently successfully tested in the Australian desert by a
joint U.S.-Australian military research team.

- The research team sent a scramjet attached to a rocket booster to an altitude of 172 miles (278km) at Mach 7.5 or seven times the speed of sound.
- Scramjet is a supersonic combustion engine that uses oxygen from the atmosphere for fuel, making it lighter and faster than fuel-carrying rockets.

Rare sighting: Brown bears spotted in Kargil

- Eight Himalayan brown bears sighted in **Kargil's Drass Sector**, where the 1999 war had bring about destruction with their habitats.
- It is first ever sighting of a group of bears. No such sighting has ever been reported from J&K, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand, where these animals are distributed.
- Himalayan brown bear is also known as the Himalayan red bear and Isabelline bear. In the IUCN list of 'vulnerable' category animals the bear is included.
