NATIONAL

World's largest bird festival organized in Agra to promote Eco-tourism

- The festival has been organized to encourage bird conservation and eco-tourism in a backward area of the state and concentrates on the discussion of State's extinct bird species along with their conservation.
- About 40 experts from 26 countries and more than 100 Indian experts visited the festival.
- National Chambal Sanctuary is a tri-state protected area of Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh in Northern India. It is home to critically endangered gharial, the red-crowned roof turtle and the Ganges river dolphin.

Hailakandi District in Assam becomes first to Pay Wages to Tea workers via Bank Account

- Following demonetisation of Rs 500 and 1000 currency notes from November 9, Assam government had set December 15 as the deadline for cashless transactions to tea plantation workers.
- 504 workers of **Burnie Braes Tea Estate** received their wages through bank accounts and the payment was made through five **Banking Correspondents (CSPs) of Assam Gramin Vikash Bank.**

Union HRD Ministry launches Vittiya Saksharata Abhiyan

- Vittiya Saksharata Abhiyan (VISAKA) was launched to make people aware about cashless economic system.
- Under it, young students and faculty members will be roped to encourage and motivate people to use a digitally enabled cashless economic system for transfer of fund.
- students and faculty members also can provide their feedback and suggestions on the initiative as well as upload the progress of their work

BSF celebrates 51st Raising Day

- The Border Security Force (BSF), the biggest border guarding force in the world celebrated its 51st Anniversary of Raising Day.
- It was created by merging various State Armed Police Battalions for achieving a better coordinated synergy between the border guarding functions in peace time and fighting the war during the eventuality on both Western and Eastern fronts.
- BSF is deployed on Indo-Pakistan International Border, Indo-Bangladesh International Border, Line of Control (LoC) along with Indian Army and in Anti-Naxal Operations.
- BSF has proven its credentials during various counter insurgency and anti-militancy operations, internal security duties, natural calamities etc.

<u>Delhi High Court reverses ban on fixed dose combination drugs</u>

- Delhi High Court has quashed ban imposed on 344 fixed dose combination (FDC) drugs by the Central Government over fears that they are potential health and safety hazards.
- India is one of the world's largest markets for FDC drugs that make up almost half the market share.
- FDC drugs are drugs having two or more active ingredients in a single dosage. They are widely used to improve patient compliance as it is easier for them to take one drug than several.
- The ban was imposed based on the recommendations of Kokate committee. It was imposed
 over fears that these drugs cause anti-microbial resistance and might even cause organ-failure
 because of high toxicity.
- It was aimed at curbing the misuse of medicines.

Hornbill Festival begins in Nagaland

- It is tourism promotional extravaganza to revive, protect and preserve the richness and uniqueness of the Naga heritage. It is also called as the 'Festival of Festivals'.
- The festival is a tribute to Hornbill, the most admired and revered bird for the Nagas for its qualities of alertness and grandeur.
- It exposes both the culture and tradition of tribal peoples, and reinforces Nagaland's identity as a unique state in India's federal union.

Graded Response System to tackle air pollution in Delhi-NCR

- The action plan proposes common pollution code for Delhi-NCR to provide graded response to health emergencies caused by noxious air due to pollution.
- Code categorizes the severity of the pollutants present in the air into four categories-moderate to poor, very poor, severe, very Severe or emergency depending upon the level of pollutants in air.
- when particulate matter (PM) 2.5 levels are above 250 to 430 micrograms per cubic metre in the ambient air it will be termed as "severe" levels of pollution.
- After air pollution reaches such alarming proportions, immediate steps will be taken. It includes ban on construction activities and implementation of road space rationing schemes.

BUSINESS & ECONOMY

RBI to Issue new Rs. 20 and Rs. 50 notes

- The new Rs 50 notes won't have inset letters in the number panels and the new **Rs 20 notes** will have the **inset letter 'L'** in both the number panels.
- The decision was taken after demonetisation of high-value currency led to the supply of new Rs 500 and Rs 2,000 notes which proved insufficient for meeting the current demand.
- The year '2016' will be printed on the reverse of the banknotes.

MSS Limit Raised To Rs. 6 Lakh Crore To Manage Liquidity

- In order to manage the extra liquidity from the system after the demonetisation, government and the **Reserve Bank of India** has sharply raised the Market **Stabilisation Scheme (MSS)** ceiling to **Rs. 6 lakh crore** from Rs. 30,000 crore on December 2, 2016.
- MSS Bonds issued by the government are aimed at providing the central bank with a **stock of securities** to intervene in the market for managing liquidity.
- Money raised via these bonds are not used for government spending and are sequestered and maintained in a separate account.
- RBI also auctioned the 28-day Cash Management Bills (CMB) of Government of India worth Rs.
 20,000 crore using 'Multiple Price Auction' method.
- As part of liquidity management exercise, RBI on November 26 asked lenders to temporarily maintain an incremental cash reserve ratio (CRR) of 100 per cent. The actual current rate of CRR is 4 per cent.

- Senior IPS officer Rakesh Asthana has taken additional charge of the post of Director, Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI).
- Rakesh Asthana is 1984 batch IPS officer of Gujarat Cadre. Prior to this appointment he was serving as additional director in the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI).
- He had held several important assignments in Gujarat. He has also served as the commissioner of police, Vadodara and Surat.
- He had headed the special investigation team (SIT), which probed the Godhra train arson of February 2002.

- India is the first country to win Miss Supranational twice in three years.
- Miss Supranational along with Miss World and Miss Universe is among the top three beauty pageants on the planet.

- Hindi poet Leeladhar Jagoori will be honoured with the prestigious Gangadhar National
 Award for the year 2015 by the Sambalpur University

- Leeladhar Jagudi is an Indian teacher, journalist and poet of Hindi literature hailing from Uttarakhand.
