Tamil Nadu govt announce Rs 2247 cr for drought affected farmers

- Tamil Nadu government has sanctioned Rs 2,247 crore to drought-hit farmers in Tamil Nadu after the report submitted to the government by senior officials.
- The report suggested that **Rs 2,247 crore for 50,34,237 acres** in which crops were cultivated during samba season.
- Farmers whose rain-fed lands will get **Rs 3,000 per acre** and **Rs 5,465 per acre** to farmers who have lands which are dependent on irrigating
