- The accord does not apply to the United Kingdom or Ireland.
- The accord now requires formal signature by the **28 member states** and the European Parliament.

- INS Kalvari is the first of India's six Scorpene-class submarines which are being built under the Project 75.
- The diesel powered Kalvari (Scorpene) class submarines have superior stealth. They use guided
 weapons such as tube-launched anti-ship missiles and torpedoes on enemy submarines from
 the surface or underwater.
